PechaKucha Guidance

The PACR Pathway Event is taking place on 18th October 2019 at the Institute for Historical Research in London. With around 90 members expected to attend it is a great opportunity to hear from speakers sharing their experiences of accreditation, discussing recent developments as well as the opportunity to present yourself!

Delegates have been invited to put themselves forward to deliver what is called a PechaKucha.

What is a PechaKucha?

Essentially it's a very simple presentation format where you show 20 images, each for 20 seconds. The images of course relate to what you're talking about and are set on timer to automatically advance after 20 seconds to keep you on track. It is a great presentation format to deliver a punchy and 'to the point' presentation'. The presentation will therefore last a total of 400 seconds or 3 minutes and 40 seconds (no extensions!).

What can you cover?

You can choose to talk about almost anything you want to, it's a great opportunity to share ideas, new areas of work, development opportunities, something you've learned. All we ask is that you tell us what you're going to talk about! Slots are limited and we will make the final selection so that we have a good range of topics for people to present.
