Media Brief

What do I need to do?

You are required to prepare a write up of your CPD activity, that will be featured prominently on Icon's website and social media channels.

Minimum requirements:

- 1 article
- 300-400 words
- 2 pictures

Suggested:

- 2-3 articles
- 150-250 words (each)
- 4-5 pictures or video

Note that articles and social media posts with multiple pictures or videos typically perform up to 150% better than those without. Additionally, documenting the activity in videos would require less words to be written into the article.

Taking pictures/video

If taking photos and/or video with a smartphone, please ensure you do this in landscape mode (not vertically) and in good lighting. We want to experience what you did! Ideal photos would be:

- Close-ups and "before & after" shots of the project if doing a course or workshop
- Shots of the speakers or slides if attending a conference
- Group photos and even selfies!

How to send us content

You should attach your document and media to an e-mail to pwhife@icon.org.uk
Please do not insert your images into the document, as this will compress them and reduce their quality – please attach them separately.

Alternatively, you can send us your images or videos via free file transfer services such as Google Drive, WeTransfer or DropBox

Remember to label your media or include an additional document with captions and copyright requirements.
